



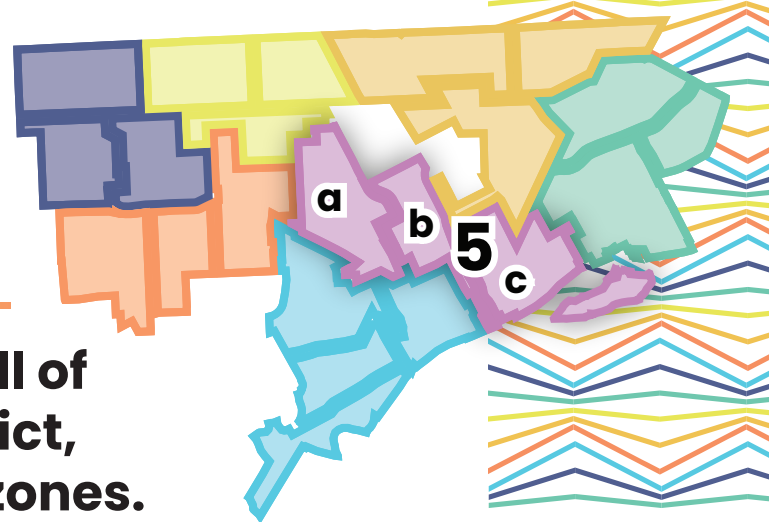
# Neighborhood Vitality Index

NVI surveys Detroit residents across the whole city to hear what's going on in their lives and neighborhoods.

## In District 5 in 2025

- 90%** feel safe or very safe in their neighborhoods
- 57%** report participating in block, neighborhood, community, or school groups
- 64%** were able to get healthcare without money being a barrier
- 17%** report owning a business

...and much more about neighborhood strength, chances for residents to get ahead, quality of life, fairness, and how young people are doing!



**We can now share results for all of Detroit, each City Council District, and NVI's local neighborhood zones.**

- 6,712** Detroit residents participated in 2025
- 1,130** of those were from **Council District 5**
- 22** neighborhood zones allow us to report reliable data at a scale that is more useful for taking action.

**There are now over 10,000 survey responses from 2024 and 2025, with more to come in 2026!**
